Dear Seneca Falls Central School District Residents,

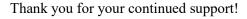
At the April 11, 2024 Board of Education meeting, the Seneca Falls Central School District BOE adopted a proposed spending plan of \$36,886,754. Our proposed tax levy increase of 2% is under the maximum allowable tax levy limit of 3.44% for our district. We

have prepared a budget that is reflective of our effort to sustain the quality education we are providing for students while being fiscally responsible.



For 2024-2025, our efforts to improve literacy will be at the forefront of our efforts. Through research-based practices in the Science of Reading and the addition of a K-8 Instruc-

tional Coach, we will better support our students and teachers as we make instructional shifts in reading. Additionally, we will continue to increase our graduation rates, enhance school safety, and support the social and emotional health of our students. The budget outlined in this newsletter was created to maintain current programming and promote the district mission to provide quality educational opportunities and experiences for all students in a safe and positive environment that promotes academic excellence.

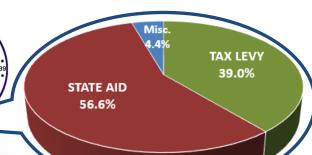

PROPERTY TAX LEVY

New York State law requires school districts to establish a tax cap, or maximum allowable levy limit. Allowable Levy is set at the Cost of Living, CPI (4.1%) or the state's tax cap of 2%, whichever is less. The SFCSD proposed 2.00% Tax Levy increase is below the SFCSD Maximum Allowable Levy Limit of 3.44%.

WHERE AND HOW DO I VOTE?

All Seneca Falls Central School District voters must be U.S. Citizens, at least 18 years of age, and a resident of the school district for the past 30 days. Voting on the School Budget, Bus Purchases and the election of members of the Board of Education will take place from **12:00 to 8:00 PM on Tuesday, May 21, 2024** in the **Operations Center (2 Butler Ave)**. The annual public hearing for the school budget will be on Thursday, May 9th at 6:00 PM. The public hearing will be in the Robert McKeveny Training Room at the Operations Center. BALLOT PROPOSITIONS

- **PROPOSITION #1:** Authorization to expend the sum of thirty-six million, eight hundred eighty-six thousand, seven hundred fifty-four dollars (\$36,886,754.00) in the 2024-2025 school year with such amount to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of such School District, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law.
- **PROPOSITION #2:** Authorization to purchase four buses for the transportation of district students, for a sum of money not to exceed six hundred, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000.00); said amount to be expended in the 2024-2025 fiscal year; said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be withdrawn from the district's "Capital Reserve Fund-Purchase of Buses" and/or the unassigned fund balance, in accordance with the Education Law and Local Finance Law.
- **PROPOSITION #3:** Shall the sum of three hundred sixty-seven thousand dollars (\$367,000.00) be raised by annual levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the Seneca Falls Central School District for the purpose of funding the Seneca Falls Library?
- **PROPOSITION #4:** Authorization to establish Capital Reserve Fund for Technology Equipment & Infrastructure in accordance with NY Education Law Section 3651 to be known as the "Technology Equipment & Infrastructure Capital Reserve Fund 2024". The maximum term of the reserve shall be ten (10) years and shall not exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) plus accrued interest.
