
Objective 2:




Objective 2:

Current School Levies




Emergency Levy:

Current Operating Expense Levy:


- Originally passed November 2013 for 5.9 mills

General Fund Revenue Sources - FY23 Actual




General Fund Expenditures - FY23 Actual






General Fund Expenditures - FY23 Actual








State Foundation Revenue History



Enrollment Trends




Cost Per Pupil

For consideration: Pay particular attention to the aging middle school facilities, along with the AC and other air quality concerns in the elementary buildings.

Facility Efforts



- November 2023: Bond levy rejected
- January-April 2024: Board resumes facility planning discussions
- May 2024: Board vote on facility plan and future bond
- Summer 2024: Facility Projects (~\$3 million investment)
- September October 2024: Community Q&A
- November 2024: Possible bond issue on ballot









