At the Middle School they are making a freedom quilt.

Dr. Scollins and Mrs. Cerewonka update about the Literacy Committee, focusing on Elementary Literacy. TLA, Teaching Learning Alliance, a consulting group, did a walkthrough in the district to help make a plan for the next year in terms of literacy instruction. Meetings with math and reading specialists are scheduled to review end of year benchmark tests. The district is looking at a variety of assessment tools to use in grades K - 5 and beyond.

Summer Learning program was expanded so that all who applied have been accepted into the program beginning July 12.

The Wellness Committee recently met and new Wellness information will be shared through the Navigator soon.

Strategic Planning Steering Team met and will be ready to present the content for approval at the next meeting.

Cohasset Trek Grand Canyon Trip – Bob Erlandsen & Jon Fortin – Teachers

Want to plan eighth grade trip for next year with COVID Protocol and possibly a high school trip for students who were not able to do a trip due to COVID.

Finance – Mrs. Owen provides an FY21 May Finance update. SpEd Tuitions are higher than expected as a result of changes in outplacements. The utility budget will break even. In conclusion, FY21 has been a fiscally challenging year but we've been able to maintain a balanced budget and close the year in good shape.

The committee asks questions and engages in discussion with Mrs. Owen.

Kindergarten Tuition – The committee's intent was to provide a reimbursement to this year's families as we did last year. Chairman MacLellan clarified information that had been shared at earlier meetings. Mrs. Owen identified that ESSER II grant funds allow for an \$800 refund to the 98 kindergarten families. The committee asked questions and clarified understanding.
