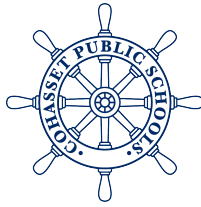


COHASSET PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROGRESS REPORT



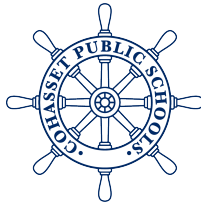
