Winter Science Academy

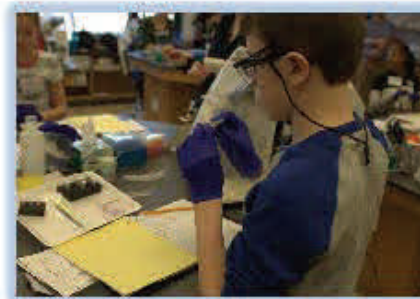

Participating middle school students attend the *Forensics Institute of Bridgewater (FIB)*, an exciting hands-on class in which students act as crime scene analysts. Working with Senior Scientists, students learn how to collect and analyze fingerprints from a simulated crime scene, perform blood type analysis, and get closer to solving the mystery using the cutting edge technique, DNA fingerprinting.

Program Fee: \$325.00

This program is designed for students currently in grades 6–8.

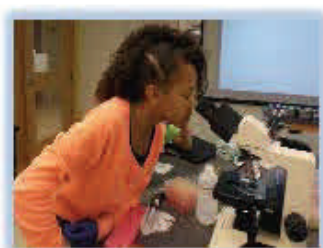
Limited scholarships are available to students who demonstrate significant financial need and academic merit.

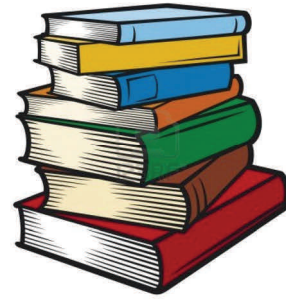

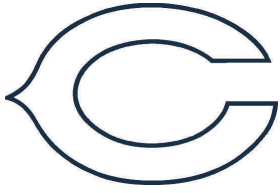
Learning Commons
