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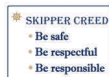

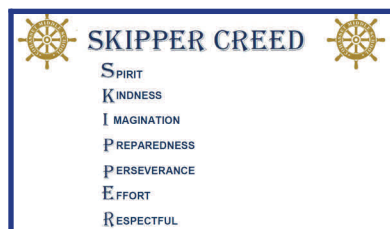
from the desk of Carolyn Connolly...

What's Happening in the Learning Commons!

The new CMHS Learning Commons is enhancing educational experiences for both students and faculty at CMHS! All sort of classes are taking advantage of the great space. Just this past month, we've had bookings by Music, Science, English, Social Studies, and Research classes. Students and teachers alike are enjoying the flexibility of the space, whether for individual study, group collaboration, or whole-class activities.

In addition to classes, Middle School students utilize the space daily for their TST period (with passes from their teachers), whether it's to do research, work with a group, or find a book. PSO parent volunteers assist Mrs. Cerruti during Middle School TST so that students can get assistance with checking in/out books while Mrs. Cerruti helps individual students. As I type, the Learning Commons is filled with Middle School students working in all the various spaces!

Our weekly High School Utility, on Thursdays, is packed as well... with high school students who each find a spot that suits their study style. High School Utility students can reserve a spot ahead of time via our [online reservation form](#) (available on the CMHS Library website) to be guaranteed a spot if the Learning Commons fills up, or walk-in (and sign in) if we haven't reached capacity (79 seats). Students can even use the enormous interactive touch screen to practice presenting or run a study session. (Mrs. Cerruti can book the touchscreen area for students and provide them with easy instructions for hooking up their device.) Again, PSO parent volunteers assist with High School Utility to allow for maximum assistance to all students.

In addition to all of the above, High School students in Virtual High School classes use the Learning Commons on a daily basis, and the Learning Commons is open for drop in during both Middle and High School breaks. Finally, Mrs. Cerruti keeps the Learning Commons open after school every day until 3pm. And thanks to PSO parent volunteers, the Learning Commons is open every Thursday until 3:30pm for Middle School Homework Center. The Learning Commons is always a very active place after school, whether for Latin Intramural or students just looking for a place to study alone or with a group.

Students are enjoying the new space as are teachers and we are confident the class calendar will continue to be filled up and the spaces in use throughout the rest of the year!

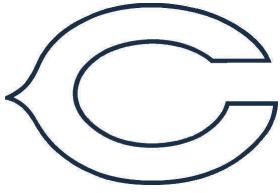
