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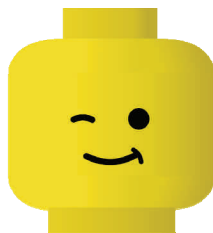

Entries will be judged by MFA candidates and **finalists will be chosen by Former US Poet Laureate Robert Pinsky.**

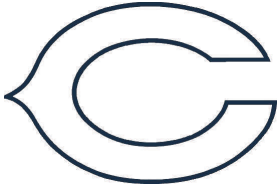
The JFK Library will host an event for all entrants (as well as family members and teachers) in early December.
