Parent Support Group

ToughLove is a program that is designed to help families who are constantly in crisis, because of one or more members who are exhibiting unacceptable behavior. The essence of ToughLove is support. It is a network of parents and professionals working with them to bring change in the lives of their young people who are impossible, incorrigible, uncontrollable, addicted, physically or verbally abusive, in trouble at school, in trouble with the law and destroying the family.

With the help and support of others the parents learn how to deal with these out of control young people by refusing to support their destructive life styles. To be able to take tough stands and to no longer tolerate these negative behaviors parents need to change how they react to their children.

Parents learn new techniques and ideas from parents who have success in getting control of their lives again.

When a young person is out-of-control, the whole family is out-of-control and in danger of being torn apart. Parents need to find new ways to respond and stop being part of the problem. ToughLove teaches parents how to become part of the solution.

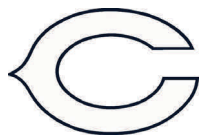
