HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETES

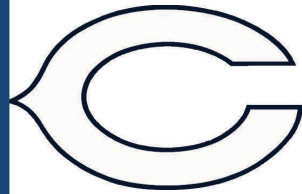
Sports physicals will be held on Tues. March 8th at 2:15 PM in the nurse's office.
