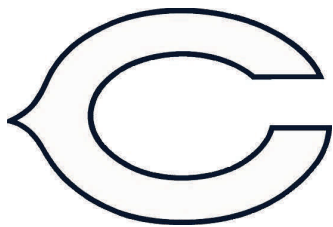

Guide for parents to identify the early warning signs of substance misuse!

The “Hidden in Plain Sight” initiative helps parents spot signs of at-risk behaviors. The initiative uses an educational display of a teenager’s bedroom to test parent’s knowledge of common household items that can be substance abuse warning signs.
