### 2024-2025 STUDENT COURSE ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. In addition to these instructions, you should have received a "Student Course Enrollment Worksheet". The worksheet lists all classes offered at La Plata High School. You will use this sheet to choose your classes for next year. If you misplace your worksheet, please visit the Counseling Office for a replacement.
2. The Charles County Public Schools "High School Program of Studies" is a document that provides information on graduation requirements, grading policies, and other general information. More importantly, there are descriptions of all the courses listed on your Student Course Enrollment Worksheet. Please refer to the descriptions for any courses you are considering before completing your Student Course Enrollment Worksheet. Be sure to refer to the Program of Studies labeled with the year that you began high school. You can find this document on the CCPS website at <https://www.ccboe.com/academics/high-school-program-of-studies>.
3. Please make sure you review your graduation requirements carefully. The "Course History" tab in your StudentVue shows your progress towards completing your requirements. You can also utilize the "Graduation Status Report" on the reverse side of these instructions to help you keep track of your credits throughout high school and plan for next year.
4. If you need assistance with choosing your classes, please schedule an appointment with your School Counselor. To schedule an appointment, scan the QR code hanging throughout the building or go to <https://linktr.ee/LPHSCounselors>.
5. All students must complete at least one graduation pathway listed on the "Completer Pathway Options" chart on the reverse side of these instructions. Please review this information to assist with developing and completing your four-year plan. More information about the Career & Technology Education (CTE) programs can be found on pages 18-38 of the "High School Program of Studies".
6. When completing your Student Course Enrollment Worksheet, you must sign up for seven classes and three alternate elective courses. Unless otherwise told by your teacher or School Counselor, you will sign up for the required core academic classes for your grade level. You will also sign up for three additional courses that fulfill graduation requirements, that are part of your graduation pathway and/or are electives you wish to take. Lastly, you will choose 3 alternate elective courses to enter in the "Alternate Courses" space at the end of the worksheet.
7. Your current core academic teachers will give their recommendation for placements in A-level, honors, or AP courses. CTE teachers will also approve your enrollment in graduation pathway courses. If your parent/guardian disagrees with the teacher's recommendation, they should contact the teacher to discuss their concerns. After discussing it with the teacher, if your parent/guardian wishes to override the recommendation, a written request must be attached to your Student Course Enrollment Worksheet when it is submitted. Parent/guardian requests will be honored when the schedule is prepared for next year.
8. Maryland state law requires that each student take a math course each year while in high school and students must earn 4 high school math credits to graduate. Even if you completed math credits in middle school, you must still enroll in a math course each year you are in high school. For admission to any public college or university in Maryland, you will be required to take a math class at the Algebra II or higher level in your senior year of high school. Additionally, while CCPS requires two credits in the same foreign language for graduation, many colleges either require or prefer students to have 3 credits of the same foreign language.
9. If you are planning to attend college, it is important to take challenging courses throughout high school. If you are not already challenging yourself, you should seriously consider selecting at least one higher-level course for next year. Most college admissions officers tell us that taking challenging courses is more important than earning straight A's in high school.
10. Schedule changes each year are only made in extreme circumstances, such as errors in academic placement. For this reason, you must be very careful with course selection. Please select the correct levels with the help of your parents/guardians and your current teachers. Carefully choose your electives and alternates and make sure these are classes you will be happy with. You should review the "High School Program of Studies" for a description of the course before signing up for the class. If you're still unsure about a course, please speak with your School Counselor or the current course teacher before selecting the class.
11. Your Student Course Enrollment Worksheet must be submitted by the deadline: **Friday, January 12th**.
12. The completed worksheets should be turned in to the appropriate grade-level box outside the Counseling Office in the Commons Area. You may turn in your worksheet to the boxes before 1st period and during lunch.
13. From February 1st-9th students will be called by grade-level to the cafeteria to input course requests into StudentVue. Your worksheet will be returned to you at that time to assist with this process. School Counselors will also be available to help.
14. School Counselors will meet with each student individually from February 12th-March 11th to finalize course requests.
