The three main supports **Honest Game** provides for schools/districts are as follows:

### **Honest Game Software**

Automated academic eligibility/admissibility tracking that provides individualized post-secondary plans for every student across all divisions of college athletics. This software saves counselors time and reduces risk, as there are no more manual calculations needed. In addition, it drives parent/student engagement and unlocks many more post-secondary pathways. College coaches love it as well, as it turns any high school transcript into a college compliance ready report.

NOTE: This is best used for "all students" as it is much more cost-effective, to ensure you are not missing students that only play club sports or start sports later in high school and your IT team will appreciate not parsing out students (which creates work for them). We can also track activities as well - theater, band, etc. This includes a Student-Athlete Profile and Sample Letters for students to customize to college coaches.

### **NCAA Portal Audit/Maintenance**

Honest Game Academics & Compliance experts will ensure the classes your students are taking are properly granted NCAA credit, updated/maintained in the portal, including the grade scale, non-traditional course offerings, support document submissions/appeals (particularly ELL), support student tasks and consult on individual cases (e.g., early grad, re-class, ELL, IEP, etc.).
