

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS UPDATE FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE DISTRICTWIDE

The District is pleased to share that the majority of construction projects included in the community-approved 2017 bond plan will be completed, on schedule, by summer's end 2023. Through astute planning by the District's facilities department and architects, the improvement projects have continued unabated over recent years with minimal impact from the pandemic shutdown, subsequent supply chain issues, and price increases.

Projects in the 2017 bond plan, plus the 2019 capital projects proposition approved by the community, touch every building in the District, from the creation of state-of-the-art library/media centers at all secondary schools, Saddle Rock and John F. Kennedy elementary schools; to classroom additions at E.M. Baker and Lakeville elementary schools; to the award-winning new auditorium at E.M. Baker Elementary School. Below are those projects that
