CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS UPDATE

WINDOWS, ROOFS, WALKWAYS, ROADWAYS, SCIENCE LABS AND SO MUCH MORE.

This past summer and the early days of fall saw a flurry of construction, renovation and repair work all across the District (see pages two and three for a summary of projects). This work was funded through the District's annual budget and the 2016 Capital Reserve Fund. In December of last year, work began on the installation of new security vestibules in District school buildings. Completion is anticipated in February. The project scope for this work includes the creation of double-door security vestibules at main entrances; electronic locks on both interior and exterior doors; an intercom buzzer system; an additional security camera at each entrance; and a secure pass through for drop-off items. Main entrance doors, adjacent glass, and interior entrance doors will be coated with shooter attack resistant film or glazing. Keeping all these projects moving forward, coordinating and monitoring the work of the numerous contractors and suppliers involved in these projects, has been Mr. Alfredo Cavallaro, the District's director of buildings and grounds. We want to thank Mr. Cavallaro for his professionalism, diligence, and dedication to the Great Neck Public Schools.



Maintaining and improving, when needed, the health, safety, and security of our District's school buildings and other facilities is absolutely vital. That is why renovation and repair projects will continue over the course of 2019 and beyond, funded through the community-approved May 2017 bond referendum. In addition, ensuring exceptional, state-of-the-art educational spaces for our students is equally essential. A good portion of the projects slated for the summer of 2019 address these issues. These projects are summarized on the back page of this newsletter.

The District will continue to provide you with updates on the many capital projects taking place across the District. We are committed to ensuring that your tax dollars are spent wisely. All this work helps ensure the safety of all who use our schools, and secures the community's investment in the District's physical assets.
