Thursday, June 10 and Friday, June 11: Yearbook AND Cap and Gown distribution during periods 8-9 and after school.

Monday, June 14: Senior iPad collection in social studies classes.

Tuesday, June 15- Friday, June 18: Graduation ticket distribution. Students may pick up his/her/their 4 tickets in the main office (Every student must pick up his/her/their own tickets).
