The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Monday, April 15, 2024 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Catie Brown, Lenna Ojure, and Neil Whitmore; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Ashley Rhodenizer, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Brown called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Ojure recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Ojure, seconded by Trustee Whitmore, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 5:03 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 5:45 p.m.

Trustee Ojure read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Ojure, and seconded by Trustee Whitmore the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Whitmore, seconded by Trustee Ojure, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-091-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student is strongly encouraged to continue counseling or seek counseling.
2. Student is mandated to attend summer school to complete required credits.
3. Student is subject to searches when entering a Rockbridge County Public Schools' building.
4. Student will be placed on home-based instruction with a teacher.
5. The Discipline Committee will explore tutoring options for student.
6. Student will be provided transportation for summer school program.
