

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, May 24, 2023 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Catie Brown, Kathy Burant, and Wendy Lovell; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer and Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Brown called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Burant recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss three student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Burant, seconded by Trustee Lovell, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 4:34 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 5:43 p.m.

Trustee Burant read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Burant, and seconded by Trustee Lovell, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Lovell, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-057-09 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will be notified of a back to school meeting with the Maury River Middle School administration and a Rockbridge County School Board Discipline Committee meeting in August of 2023. Student will not be allowed to return to school unless she attends both of these forthcoming meetings.

Upon motion by Trustee Lovell, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-056-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student is suspended for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year.

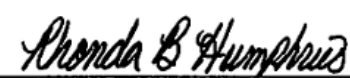

1. Student is encouraged to research the harmful effects of vaping and using THC.
2. Student will be required to complete the Rockbridge County High School vaping packets and modules this summer. An Rockbridge County High School administrator will provide the vaping packets and additional information on how to complete them.
