

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, February 22, 2023 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Wendy Lovell; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Berkstresser called the meeting to order at 4:58 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Berkstresser recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 4:59 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 6:00 p.m.

Trustee Brown read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Brown, and seconded by Trustee Lovell, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Lovell, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-080-09 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to MRMS on Thursday February 23, 2023.
2. Student and family will follow through with the FAPT recommendations.
3. Student will have daily check-ins with Mrs. Hoehne.
4. Student will attend the weekly social skills sessions with Mr. T.J. Wills.
5. Student will meet daily with school counselor for the first ten (10) days of return, beginning on February 23, 2023.
