

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, January 11, 2023 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Wendy Lovell; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Berkstresser called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Brown recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Lovell, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 5:13 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 5:58 p.m.

Trustee Berkstresser read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Berkstresser, and seconded by Trustee Lovell, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

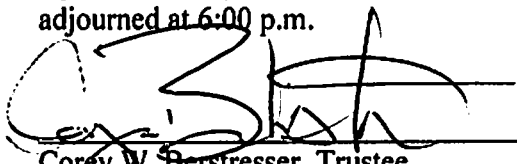

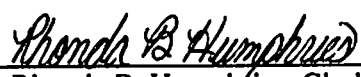
Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Lovell, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-084-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will be assigned to in-school suspension, in room 200, from January 12, through January 18, 2023 in order to make up any missed assignments or tests.
3. Student will return to regular classes on January 19, 2023.
4. Student will be referred, by school counselor, to receive SIS support services.
5. Student will attend after school tutoring in 8th period at least two days a week.
6. Student will remain in classes and exit only for emergency purposes, SIS counseling, brief visits to school counselor, or a bathroom break.
7. Student attendance will be monitored by school counselor and administration, due to excessive periodic absences during the school day.
