

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, November 30, 2022 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Kathy Burant; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Berkstresser recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss four student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:01 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 7:53 p.m.

Trustee Burant read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Burant, and seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-090-9 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will be served as a homebased student through May 2023. MRMS administration will reach out to the family and notify them of the procedures and which teacher will be providing the instructional support.
2. Student will be on social probation through May 26, 2023.
3. Student will be required to complete educational packets regarding the dangers of vaping.
4. Student's parent/guardian will contact MRMS administration at 540-463 3129 to schedule a time for student to come into the building to take SOL assessments.

Upon motion by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-089-9 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to MRMS on December 1, 2022.
2. Student will be required to complete educational packets regarding the dangers of vaping.
3. Student will participate in a school based social skills training class that meets at MRMS.
4. Student will be compelled to attend, beginning in January of 2023, the Family Preservation Substance Abuse and Vape group. MRMS administration will provide additional information with regards to specific dates and times, as soon as the information becomes available.
5. Student will be on social probation through May 26, 2023.

Upon motion by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-088-9 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

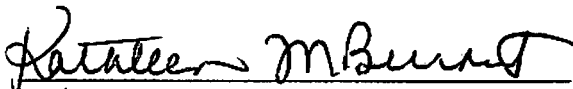
1. Student will be served as a home-based student through May 2023. The timeline may be adjusted based on the results of a Child Study.
2. The staff of MRMS will convene a Child Study for student.
3. Based on the results of the Child Study process, MRMS staff will review and explore various placement options, as appropriate, for student.
4. Student will be on social probation through May 26, 2023.
5. Student will be referred to FAPT by school counselor.

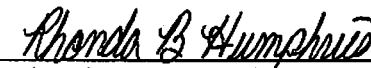
Upon motion by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-087-9 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to MRMS on Monday December 12, 2022.
2. Upon return on Monday December 12, 2022, student will be assigned to the Alternative Education program.
3. Beginning on Monday December 12, 2022, student will be required to complete educational packets regarding the dangers of vaping.
4. Student will be required to complete educational packets that will be delivered from MRMS via sibling.
5. Student will participate in a school based social skills training class that meets at MRMS.
6. Student will be compelled to attend, beginning in January of 2023, the Family Preservation Substance Abuse and Vape group. MRMS administration will provide additional information with regards to specific dates and times, as soon as the information becomes available.
7. Student will be on social probation through May 26, 2023.
