

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Tuesday, November 15, 2022 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Kathy Burant; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:29 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Berkstresser recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:30 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 6:25 p.m.

Trustee Burant read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Burant, and seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

- Trustee Berkstresser - Aye
- Trustee Brown - Aye
- Trustee Burant - Aye

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-091-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to RCHS on Monday November 21, 2022.
2. On November 21, 2022, student will be assigned to in-school detention for two (2) school days.
3. Student will return to regular schedule on November 28, 2022.
4. Student will be subjected to a daily screening by wand as well as a daily back pack search, through December 31, 2022. After December 31, 2022, student will be subject to random wand screenings as well as random back pack searches.
5. Student will be on social probation through March 10, 2023.
