

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Thursday, September 8, 2022 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Kathy Burant; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Burant recommended that the Board go into a ***Closed Meeting*** to discuss two student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Burant, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the ***Closed Meeting*** at 5:02 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 7:07 p.m.

Trustee Berkstresser read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Berkstresser, and seconded by Trustee Burant, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-094-09 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to MRMS on Friday October 21, 2022.
2. On October 21, 2022, student will be assigned to in-school detention through November 14, 2022. This environment will enable student to make up missed assignments and provide a secure environment as transitioning into new medications.
3. On the first day student returns to school, student will complete an educational packet regarding the dangers and effects of vaping.
4. Student will be on social probation through December 31, 2022. The principal is prepared to offer one exception to this probationary period. Student will be allowed to try out for the basketball team.
5. The RCPS discipline committee will be notified within 24 hours of any and all referrals of a discipline nature.

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-093-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will return to RCHS on Friday October 21, 2022.
2. On October 21, 2022, student will be assigned to in-school detention for ten (10) school days.
3. Student will be assigned to 8th period for two days a week in order for student to receive tutoring support for assignments. This after school tutoring will begin the week of October 24, 2022.
4. Student will meet with school counselor at least one day per school week through at least December 31, 2022. This may extend through the remainder of the school year, as deemed necessary by school counselor.
5. Student will be on social probation through December 31, 2022.
6. Student has been referred for TDT counseling.
