

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, August 24, 2022 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown and Kathy Burant; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Angela Wilder, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Berkstresser recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss two student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Berkstresser, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:01 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 6:28 p.m.

Trustee Burant read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Burant, and seconded by Trustee Brown, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-100-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student may return to Rockbridge County High School on August 31, 2022.
2. On August 31, student will be assigned to in-school detention for a single day to complete the Vaping Modules Packet and to be able to transition back into the building.
3. Student will be on Social Probation through December 31, 2022 which prohibits student from attending extracurricular activities for RCHS.
4. As of September 1, 2022, Student's schedule will be amended to include four class periods in the Alternative Education Program.

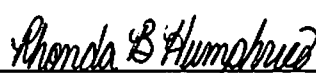
Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2223-99-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student may return to Rockbridge County High School on September 1, 2022.
2. On September 1, student will be assigned to in-school detention for a single day to complete the Vaping Modules Packet and to be able to transition back into the building.
3. Student will be on Social Probation through December 31, 2022 which prohibits student from attending extracurricular activities for RCHS.
4. Student will be referred for TDT and counseling by school counselor.
5. As of September 2, 2022, student's schedule will be amended to include six class periods in the Alternative Education Program and a single class period of Communications Systems.
