

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, April 27, 2022 at Maury River Middle School.

Present: Trustee Catie Brown, Chairman Wendy Lovell, and Trustee Neil Whitmore; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Christine Wood, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Brown called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Chairman Lovell recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss three student discipline matters. Motion was made by Chairman Lovell, seconded by Trustee Whitmore, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:04 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 7:04 p.m.

Trustee Brown read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Brown, and seconded by Chairman Lovell, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Whitmore, seconded by Chairman Lovell, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2122-86-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student may return to Rockbridge County High School on Friday, April 29, 2022.
2. Student will spend Friday, April 29, 2022 in in-school suspension and complete a vape and THC awareness module.
3. Student will be on social probation for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. During this probation period, student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property after the regular school day; nor attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.

Upon motion by Trustee Whitmore, seconded by Chairman Lovell, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2122-85-09 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student will have scheduled restroom breaks throughout the day in order to minimize student interaction with peers during unstructured times.
2. If student has any further discipline infractions, student will not be allowed to participate in any end-of-year activities.

Upon motion by Trustee Whitmore, seconded by Chairman Lovell, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2122-90-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student is suspended for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year and may return to Rockbridge County High School on August 16, 2022. Student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property during suspension; nor attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.

- 2. Student will be on social probation for the first nine-weeks of the 2022-2023 school year. During this probation period, student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property after the regular school day; nor attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
