Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Catie Brown, and Kathy Burant; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Christine Wood, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Berkstresser recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss two student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Burant,seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:32 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 7:15 p.m.

Trustee Berkstresser read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Berkstresser, and seconded by Trustee Burant, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2122-95-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

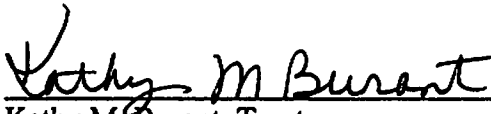
1. Student is suspended out-of-school four (4) additional days and may return to Rockbridge County High School on Monday, March 7, 2022. Student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property during suspension; nor can student attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
2. Student will spend two (2) days in in-school suspension on March 7 and March 8, 2022. During that time, student will complete a marijuana and vape awareness module course.
3. Student will be on social probation for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. Student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property after school hours during social probation; nor can student attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
4. Student's driving privileges are suspended for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year.

Upon motion by Trustee Brown, seconded by Trustee Burant, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 2122-94-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

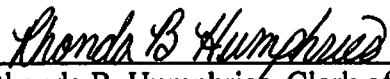
1. Student is suspended for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. Student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property during suspension; nor can student attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
2. Student will complete the marijuana and vape awareness module course during suspension which will be provided by Rockbridge County High School administration.

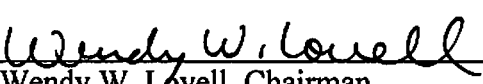
Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Chairman Lovell, and seconded by Trustee Brown, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:
