

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Wednesday, January 12, 2022 at the Rockbridge County School Board Office.

Present: Trustees Catie Brown, Kathy Burant, and Neil Whitmore; Randy Walters, Chief Operations Officer; Christine Wood, Discipline Committee Liaison.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Burant called the meeting to order at 5:27 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Burant recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss two student discipline matters. Motion was made by Trustee Whitmore, seconded by Trustee Brown, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 5:28 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Burant read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Burant, and seconded by Trustee Brown, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

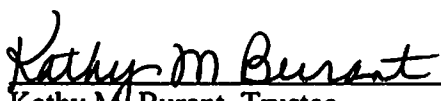
1. Student may return to Rockbridge County High School on Tuesday, January 18, 2022.

4. Student may attend Prom, provided there are no further behavior violations prior to that time.

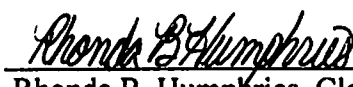
