CALL TO ORDER

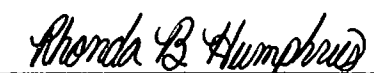
Chairman Lovell called the Public Hearing to order at 4:30 p.m. and requested that everyone rise for the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Public Hearing to receive the views of citizens on the FY21 school budget.

There was one person who addressed and expressed appreciation to the School Board and Central Office staff for the aggressive work being done on behalf of teachers as well as commending them for absorbing health care costs. The patron advocated for return of a fourth administrator at Rockbridge County High School. The patron advocated for the School Board to continue to aggressively lobby the state the change the Local Composite Index (LCI), and all proposed bills and budget amendments that the General Assembly is considering regarding teacher pay and benefits.
