

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Thursday, September 5, 2019 at the Rockbridge County School Board Office.

Present: Trustees Heather Hostetter, Wendy Lovell, and Neil Whitmore; Haywood Hand, Assistant Superintendent.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Hostetter called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Hostetter recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Lovell, seconded by Trustee Whitmore, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 4:34 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 5:24 p.m.

Trustee Hostetter read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Hostetter, and seconded by Trustee Whitmore, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

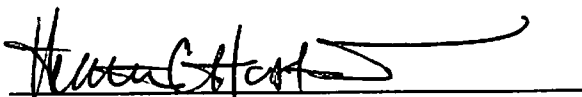

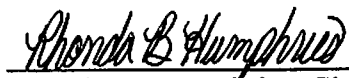
Upon motion by Trustee Lovell, seconded by Trustee Whitmore, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 1920-99-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student is suspended through the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. During this time, Rockbridge County Public Schools will provide up to three (3) hours per week of home-based instruction with a licensed teacher. Student will be enrolled in on-line classes so that student will continue with course work.
2. Student is not allowed to be on any Rockbridge County Public Schools' property during suspension; nor can student attend any extracurricular activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
