How does the Summer Reading Program work?

Read books or do activities to earn prizes!

There are three challenges which start on different dates, and prizes can be collected until the end of August:

Ocean Adventure, begins June 3

Forest Adventure, begins June 24

Tundra Adventure, begins July 15

All three challenges will close on August 31.

To earn a challenge badge, complete 5 activities from the challenge, or log 5 books read. Then, collect a prize from any JMRL branch.

How do I use Beanstack?

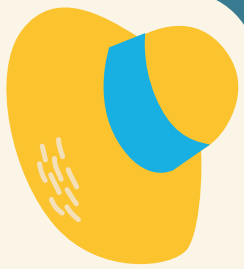
