**our largest summer yet!**



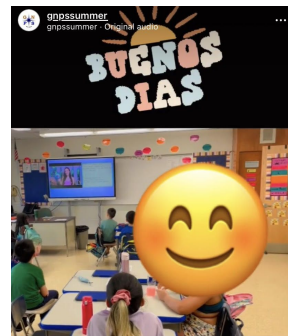
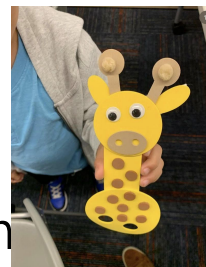
# Middle School Enrichment

- 76 courses offered to grades 5-9 (8:30 - 11:30 am)
- **Enrichment students had the option to explore:** filmmaking, rocketry, robotics, crafting, cooking, business, chess, stock market, law, acting, sewing, gaming, public speaking, painting, drawing, music, neuroscience, architecture, forensics... and more!
- Academic enrichment was provided in English, math, social studies, science, and literacy.
- **New courses:** Journalism 101, Mindfulness, The Brain and the Body, Math Playground, Get Unplugged!



# Elementary Enrichment

- **257 students** enrolled in our elementary program
- Starting in 2021: “full-day” experience (3-hour block) for grades 1-3
  - a mini classroom experience
  - daily lessons in reading, writing, and math
  - morning meetings and brain breaks
  - daily “specials” on a rotational basis (Spanish, science, music, and library)

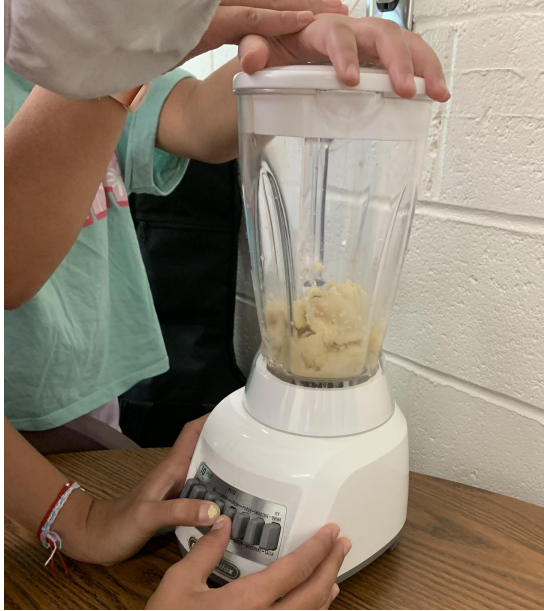

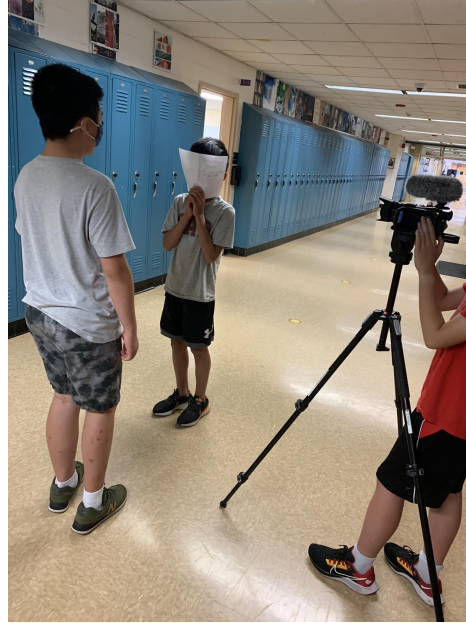

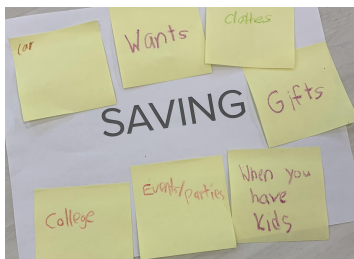

# Enrollment and Offerings - High School

- **Eleven high school classes** were offered for credit recovery
- **Two ENL classes** were offered to support our HS ENL students
- **Eight free Regents review classes** were offered from August 3-15
- A total of **189 Regents exams** were administered across nine different subject areas



# Summer 2022 Highlights

- **Technology**

- Every student had access to an iPad
- Grades 5-12 traveled w/ them daily
- Grades K-4 kept them in their classrooms

- **Transportation**

- Before opening, bus passes were emailed home with bus number, bus stop, and pickup and dropoff times
- 20 large buses used to transport students to/from program

- **Security**

- one lockdown and two fire drills
- creation of identification badges for OOD staff, student assistants and volunteered, and non-GNPS HS students
