## **SUMMER PE**

# **ACADEMIC SUMMER SCHOOL**

Urbana High School will not offer in person summer school, but students will have an opportunity to recover credits online for free during the months of June and July! The district will be incurring all costs for summer school this year. Counselors will speak to students about the course offerings and what they should take. There will be a MANDATORY informational meeting for students AND parent/guardian on May 31st in the cafeteria. Option #1: White Cap & Gown ordered through Jostens

## **INFORMATION FOR THE CLASS OF 2025**

# **PROMOTION POLICY**

The student's year in high school, along with the total number of credits earned, determines the grade level. The student will be promoted to the next grade when he/she meets the following criteria:

Freshmen (grade 9) - First year of HS or any student with less than 5 credits

Sophomores (grade 10) - Completed one year of HS and has at least 5 credits

Juniors (grade 11) - Completed two years of HS and has at least 11 credits

Seniors (grade 12) - Completed three years of HS and has at least 17 credits

## **SEMESTER EXAMS**

Underclassman Exams are scheduled for May 24th, May 28th, and May 29th. Semester and final exams for high school level courses are not eligible for reassessment. Students who do not return a parental permission form (attached) completed and signed to the main office by Thursday, May 16th will be required to attend from 7:35 am to 2:37 pm each exam day. Extra permission forms are available in the main office. Buses will run at the normal time. Students who ride a bus home will be required to attend the afternoon study hall. Students may not leave school property and return to ride a school bus. All absences for exam periods must be approved through the high school office. Unexcused absences will result in a failing score on the exam, as there is no reassessment option for exams.

**Exam Exemptions** 

Students may qualify for up to two (2) exam exemptions in January and up to two (2) exams in May.

Exemption Qualification – Quarter grades of A's or B's AND teacher permission

## **CHROMEBOOK RETURN**

We will be collecting all Chromebooks that have not been paid for in full Thursday, May 16th through Wednesday, May 29th. The Chromebooks will be stored at school over the summer and returned to students when they return from summer break and the payment plan is up-to-date. Chromebooks not returned will be considered lost and a \$200 fee will be added to your child's school fees. The charger is required to be returned with the Chromebook and will be stored with the device. There will be a \$25 fee for a lost charger. A lost Chromebook or a lost charger does not qualify for the fee waiver. If you intended to purchase the Chromebook, so that it may be kept over the summer, the remaining balance will need to be paid by Wednesday, May 24th. ## **PARENT ACCESS**

It is not too late to set up your Parent Access Account! You can get the registration key that is needed to create your account by contacting Kelli Marsh: <a href="mailto:kelli.marsh@urbanacitschools.org">kelli.marsh@urbanacitschools.org</a> Once you set your account up, you can view your child's grades in real time, monitor your child's attendance and communicate with teachers. Parent Access can be used on the web or through the "Progressbook Parent Student" app. Once your account is set up, you will use the same account until your child graduates. We will also be using the Parent Access portal to release testing scores (such as the Next Generation (state) Assessments and End of Course Assessments) this year.
