#### **CSDA Happenings**

Grade 4: Fourth graders will be taking their first field trip next week to the Colonial Schoolhouse. In math, students will learn about making fractions with a least common denominator (LCD). Students are finishing up their fantasy selection in reading and will move onto poetry next.

Grade 5: Fifth graders have been learning about poetry. Next week, they will begin learning about fossils.

Grade 6: Sixth graders are beginning their data collection phases of their science fair projects! This is the step they have all been working towards!

CSDA Unified Arts: Fourth grade artists are creating paper sculptures. Fifth graders are designing their own food trucks with the option to make a 3-D version. Sixth grade artists are creating tin foil character sculptures.

#### **RMMS Happenings**

**Pre-K:** Preschoolers enjoyed planting grass seed this week with parent helpers. Next week, they will be planting a garden bed outside and doing some Mother's Day crafts.

**Grade K:** Kindergarteners are working on differentiating between flat (2-dimensional) and solid (3-dimensional) shapes. They are learning to use geometric vocabulary to describe attributes of these shapes as we discuss them.

**Grade 1:** First graders will be venturing to the Stone Zoo as part of their life science unit. Thank you to the parent volunteers who are chaperoning the trip and thank you to the PTO for helping with the cost of the buses.

**Grade 2**: Second graders will continue to hone their measurement skills in math. They will be starting series book clubs in reading and learning how to write realistic fiction in writing.

**Grade 3:** Third graders will be starting reading biographies and biography research while wrapping up equivalent fractions with a pizza PBL project. Students are looking forward to their in-house Geodomes field trip!

**RMMS** Unified Arts: In art, all grades are weaving with paper: third graders are making blankets for pets, first and second graders are making watermelons, and kindergarten students are weaving cows.

- Avoid contact with ticks and avoid when possible

- Examine gear and pets
- Shower soon after being outdoors
- Check your body for ticks after being out doors

#### **COVID UPDATES: EFFECTIVE 3/1/24**

- Isolation is no longer required
- Positive Covid person should stay at home and away from others until they are at least 24 hours with symptoms getting better
- Fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications
- After this 24 hours, it is recommended to wear a well fitting mask for 5 days when around others




