

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

George Bower is a former Wingate University trustee and a retired attorney for Poisson, Poisson & Bower, a service-oriented law firm in Wadesboro and Wilmington, NC. He served as legal counsel for Anson County from 1989 to 2002 and has served as town attorney for Ansonville, Peachland, Polkton and McFarlan. In his 35 years of practicing law, Bower built a reputation for integrity, efficiency and accuracy. His practice areas included business law, real estate, and wills and estates.

Bower serves as the trustee for the James R. and Bronnie L. Braswell Charitable Trust in Wadesboro, NC. The Trust primarily supports education, health organizations, social services and the United Methodist and other Protestant and Christian churches and organizations. James Braswell was a bank president, a farmer and a former chairman of the Union County Board of Commissioners, and his wife, Bronnie, was a school teacher. Both were active members of Wingate United

Methodist Church. The Braswells are now deceased, but their generosity continues to enrich the lives of those in their community and well beyond.

Bower received degrees from UNC Chapel Hill (bachelor of arts) and Wake Forest University (Juris Doctor). He and his wife, Cynthia, live in Wadesboro, NC. Cynthia is a retired Anson County school teacher, and the couple has one son, Carl.

Lyons Gray serves on the North Carolina Utility Commission and is chair of the Board of Trustees for the Lettie Pate Whitehead Foundation.

> He formerly served as secretary of the North Carolina Department of Revenue, senior advisor to the president of the University of North Carolina system and chief financial officer for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Gray was also a six-term member of the North Carolina House of Representatives. He has served on the boards of the North Carolina Communities and Business Alliance, the Downtown Winston-Salem Partnership and the North Carolina School of the Arts Foundation, among other groups. He attended UNC Chapel Hill.

Daniel Gandarilla, Ed,D., MBA, SPHR, serves as senior vice president and chief human resources officer for Advocate Health, the parent company of Atrium Health. Gandarilla, who previously served as the senior vice president and chief talent officer for Advocate, has enterprise responsibility for core talent processes, including strategic oversight of leadership- and managementdevelopment initiatives, performance management, succession planning and talent identification, career development and mobility, and strategic

workforce planning. He also has responsibility for talent acquisition in Greater Charlotte.

Previously, Gandarilla served as vice president and chief learning officer for Texas Health Resources, where he oversaw clinical education, leadership development and succession planning, business education programs, academic partnerships, physician leadership development, continuing medical education, and the medical libraries. Outside of

healthcare, he has worked at P&G, in independent consulting, and as a teacher in the U.S. and Mexico.

Gandarilla holds a bachelor's degree in psychology and political science and a master's degree in education from Stanford University. He also holds an MBA and a doctorate in education with an emphasis in talent management from Texas Christian University. Gandarilla balances his passion for learning and leading transformational change with the most important activities in life: quality time with family, watching sports, listening to podcasts and finding quality coffee.

Cecilia Holden is president and CEO of myFutureNC, a statewide initiative focused on the state's educational-attainment goal. Among other public-service roles, she served as chief of staff for the North Carolina Department of Commerce and as director of government and community affairs for the State Board of Education.

Her private-sector experience includes positions with IBM and a registered investment advisory firm.



Holden holds a master of business administration degree from Duke University, a certificate in public administration from the University of North Carolina School of Government, and a bachelor of science degree in computer science and business from the University of North Carolina at Wilmington.



ACADEMIC REGALIA

The formal academic dress worn today originated more than 600 years ago, at Oxford and Cambridge. First a practical concession to the comfort of scholars and clerics laboring in unheated stone buildings, the apparel has changed little in appearance but has taken on a significant role in identifying the degree and alma mater of its wearer.

Gowns indicate bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. Bachelor's gowns are traditional black and are unadorned, while master's gowns have an elongated oval sleeve. The gowns of doctoral degrees are distinguished by the velvet panels on the front and the three velvet bands on the sleeves. Within the academy, only the president is entitled to wear the fourth band on the sleeve.

Hoods bear the colors of the institution from which the degree was received, and the color of the hood's border represents the academic discipline in which the degree was earned. For example white, arts and letters; scarlet, theology; dark blue, philosophy; yellow, science; pink, music; light brown, business; light blue, education; copper, economics; green, medicine; olive green, pharmacy; sage green, physical education.

Mortarboards of those with bachelor's and master's degrees carry black tassels. The gold tassel is reserved for holders of doctoral degrees.

The Wingate University Mentor Medallion, added to the academic regalia in 2018, is a two-sided pendant adorned with the University seal on one side and the Wellspring on the other. Acts 8:31 "How can I, unless someone guides me?" encircles the Wellspring. The Medallion is bestowed upon faculty, staff, and administrators who have been exemplary mentors in the areas of faith, knowledge, and service. Graduating seniors nominate their mentors for this recognition prior to each commencement.

ACADEMIC PROCESSIONAL

The academic processional is organized according to academic office and rank, in the following order: faculty marshal (mace bearer), officers of the University, professors, associate professors, assistant professors, and instructors. During the processional or recessional, audience members are requested to stand, as able.

MACE

The Mace has been used in legal and religious settings for centuries. Originally used as a defensive weapon, the mace has its roots in Roman courts, where it was used to restore order. The mace eventually came to be regarded as a symbol of authority. In a University setting, this implies the authority to grant degrees and marks significant occasions on the academic calendar.

The Wingate University mace is 42 inches in length and is made of solid dark walnut with two bronze University seals. The University seal features oak leaves (representing the oak trees that populate the Academic Quad) and the phrase "Faith, Knowledge, Service" – the University motto. The mace should always lead the ceremony and procession.

GONFALONS

Gonfalons are banners that have been used since the 12th century to designate districts and to show authority. The University has adopted these symbols as a way of honoring and celebrating the uniqueness of each college and school. The gonfalons act as representations of the principles and ideals that guide the University.

HOODING

The hooding portion of the commencement ceremony is a formal recognition of candidates graduating with a master or doctoral degree. Faculty members from their respective colleges, schools, or programs place the hood over the head of the graduate symbolizing successful completion of their program and a commitment to the pursuit of knowledge.

The Doctor of Occupational Therapy program at Wingate University recognizes its Student Occupational Therapy Association board members by bestowing upon them a green-tasseled braid. The program recognizes its Coalition of Occupational Therapy Advocate for Diversity board members by bestowing upon them a blue-, white-, and black-tasseled braid. The program recognizes its Charlotte Area Health Education Center Scholar by bestowing upon them a blue- and silver-tasseled braid.

The Pi Alpha Honor Society is a national society that recognizes significant academic achievement, leadership, research, community/professional service, and encourages a high standard of character and conduct among physician assistant (PA) students and graduates. These students are recognized by a turquoise- and gray-tasseled braid.

Wingate University recognizes students known to have served in the United States Armed Forces by bestowing upon them a red-, white-, and blue-tasseled braid to be worn over the gown.

Wingate University recognizes undergraduate students who have served as honor marshals by bestowing upon them a navy-tasseled braid to be worn over the gown.



ACADEMIC AWARDS

The **H. K. Helms Award** is presented annually to the undergraduates who have achieved the highest academic average. The award honors the memory of former Wingate Mayor and businessman H. K. Helms, who also served as chair of the Wingate University Board of Trustees.

The **Budd E. and Ethel K. Smith Award** is presented annually to the graduating senior judged to have made an outstanding contribution through leadership of fellow students.

The **C. C. Burris Award** is presented annually to the graduating senior woman who represents the ideals of scholarship, leadership, and service.

The **A. F. Hendricks Award** is presented annually to the graduating senior man who represents the ideals of scholarship, leadership, and service.

The **Fred H. Allen Award** is presented annually to the graduating senior judged to have exhibited outstanding Christian leadership and to have been involved in significant Christian service projects.

The **Jerry and Alice Surratt Award** is presented annually to the graduating senior who has made the most significant contributions in the area of international education through scholarship and service.

The **Lilly Achievement Award** is presented annually to the Doctor of Pharmacy class Valedictorian. This individual achieved the highest cumulative grade point average over the past four years.

The **Doctor of Occupational Therapy Leadership Award** is presented annually to the graduate who demonstrates significant acts of leadership that promote the common good while creating opportunities to serve the needs of others, build a sense of community, and inspire others to become servant leaders.

The **Doctor of Occupational Therapy Service Award** is presented annually to the graduate whose commitment to serving others through their time, actions, and dedication positively impacts the profession of occupational therapy, Wingate University, and the community.

The **Doctor of Occupational Therapy Scholarship Award** is presented annually to the graduate who exemplifies the role of a scholar through a commitment to the production and dissemination of scholarly works such as publications and presentations to a local, regional, national, or international audience that contribute to the profession of occupational therapy's body of knowledge.

The **Doctor of Occupational Therapy Outstanding Fieldwork Student Award** is presented annually to a graduate who exemplifies outstanding professional growth and clinical skill performance across the course of their Level II fieldwork experience and whose performance reflects extraordinary efforts toward high-level clinical reasoning and decision-making, team collaboration, verbal and written communication, and strong professional and client relationships that result in positive clinical outcomes.

The **Doctor of Occupational Therapy Outstanding Doctoral Capstone Student Award** is presented annually to the graduate who demonstrates outstanding critical thinking and servant leadership during their culminating capstone experience with the creation of an exemplary project with distinct value to their community site and the field of occupational therapy.


