Freshman Mini-mester Update (CAMPING): Medication Administration

By now, all parents should have completed the medication administration forms sent home in preparation for our camping trip. I want to reiterate that any over-the-counter and/or prescribed medication must accompany a physician's signature. We should have received all medication at this point. Again, we cannot administer any type of medication to scholars, which includes prescribed or over-the-counter without a signature (located on the medication administration form) by a physician. Once we return, all medication must be retrieved by caregivers. Thanks in advance for your cooperation. Last-minute reminders are below:

- 1. Anyone who has a serious medical condition that requires medication (epilepsy, asthma, diabetes) must have their paperwork and medicine here no later than tomorrow/Friday;
- 2. Duffel bags and sleeping bags must be here tomorrow/Friday;
- 3. Scholars must bring their backpacks on Monday with items included on the packing list;
- 4. Students should be here no later than 9:00 A.M. on Monday for departure;
- 5. No technology should be brought on the trip—phones will be confiscated;
- 6. Please reminder to make final payments;
- 7. Review the RPS S.C.O.R.E. expectations—all apply.
