MOST COMMON FAQ's and other Information:

-Graduation will be held on Tuesday, May 21st at Shawnee Mission South Stadium. Students should be at SM South at 6:20pm (Dressed in their cap/gown regalia) and report to the main office doors of SM South. Guests will be directed to the stand.

FOR GUESTS:

-If weather permits - ceremony will be outside and there is unlimited seating. Guests may sit on either side of the stadium.

- If it rains - the ceremony will be inside SM South in the gymnasium. Graduates will have 5 tickets to give to family and friends to sit in the bleachers in the gym. Overflow seating in the auditorium will be available.
- There will be seating on the track on either side for guests with mobility issues. Space is limited, so please plan for seating for the guest with mobility issues +1, and while rest of the family/friends may sit in the stands.
- There will be multiple golf carts to assist guests to the stadium. Please be patient and flag down a golf cart driver and they will do their very best to accommodate all that need assistance.
- Ceremony Guidelines - please no outside food or drink except for water. Noise makers will not be allowed during the ceremony. All guests should remain seated for the ENTIRETY of the ceremony and until all names have been read and Mr. Loe has presented the class of 2024.
- The professional photographers are the only individuals allowed on the field during the ceremony for picture taking. GRAD IMAGES will be our photographer, and families may preregister for images using this link: www.gradimages.com/registration.
- Families and guests may join graduates on the field for pictures after the ceremony.
- There is a flower/commemorative bear fundraiser that will have tables in front of the gates on both sides of the stadium as guests enter. Volunteers will also be stationed there passing out programs.
- Graduates will be directed to the gym entrance at SM South after the ceremony to pick up their diplomas. All diplomas not retrieved will be brought back to SM West and can be picked up during regular office hours.

FOR GRADUATES

- If you have not ordered a cap and gown - please see Mrs. Silverstein in the main office as soon as possible.
- If you ordered announcements from Josten's - any packages not picked up are in the Student Services office.
- Please work with your parents/guardians to ensure all outstanding fees/fines have been cleared from your account through bookkeeping. This will include all library books returned and the return of your MacBook on May 17th. Athletes should return all uniforms and equipment to coaches. Some sports may have events after graduation (those diplomas will be held in the office until the coach clears these students when they return their equipment).
- CHECK OUT SHEETS - Graduates will pick up their check out sheets from SM West teacher. MOST graduates will receive the sheet from their English teacher. If a student is not enrolled in an English class this semester, one of your other teachers will have your form. Students should have EACH of their teachers sign the form indicating all materials have been returned.
- MANDATORY rehearsal - There is a mandatory rehearsal on Friday, May 17th in the SM West main gym. Students will be released from their last final at 9:15 and should report to the gym. Lists with seat assignments will be posted in the gym and graduates should find their seat and wait for further directions. Students should take a picture of the list of seat assignments because the list will also indicate which room # the graduate should report to at SM South the night of graduation. (Students will line up in multiple rooms at SM South and then rooms will be dismissed individually to join the procession.)
- All Horizon students that are participating in the West graduation as well as West mid-year graduates should plan to arrive at the rehearsal by 9:30am on May 17th. If there is an emergency situation and a student is not able to come to the rehearsal, please report this to jennifersilverstein@smsd.org.
- Instructions and directions will be outlined for students, and graduates will be given a handout

Roll to check for pronunciation of their name. All graduates will also sign for a ticket envelope that contains 5 tickets that would be used if it rains the night of graduation.

-At the conclusion of the rehearsal, students will pick up their cap/gowns, pick up a yearbook if they ordered one and then be treated to lunch by our PTSA senior sizzle committee.

-MAY 21st - ALL GRADUATES should report to SM South Main office no later than 6:20pm. Please plan time for traffic and parking when making your plans to arrive. Graduates should come dressed in their cap/gown regalia. (There will be a purse/bag check in station by the office)

-Students should not alter their cap/gown.

-More information will be distributed at the Mandatory rehearsal.

We hope that you find this information useful. Our goal is of course to make this event as special and memorable as we can for our graduates. We are proud of all their accomplishments and want to celebrate them during this distinguished ceremony.

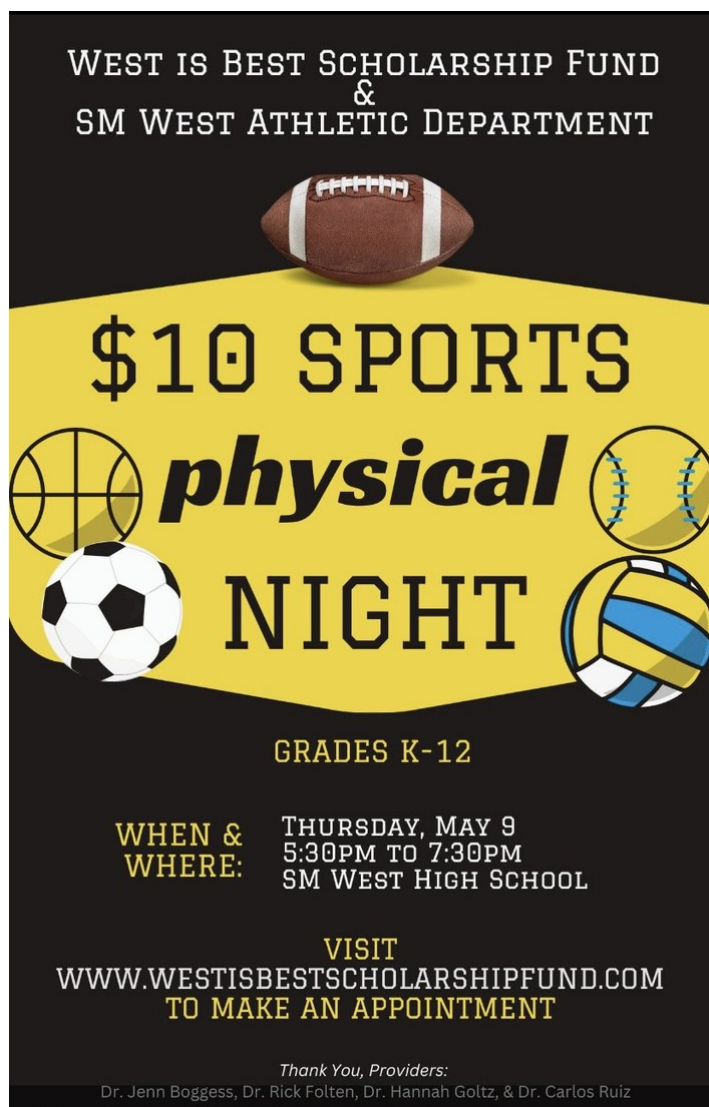
From SM West Athletics

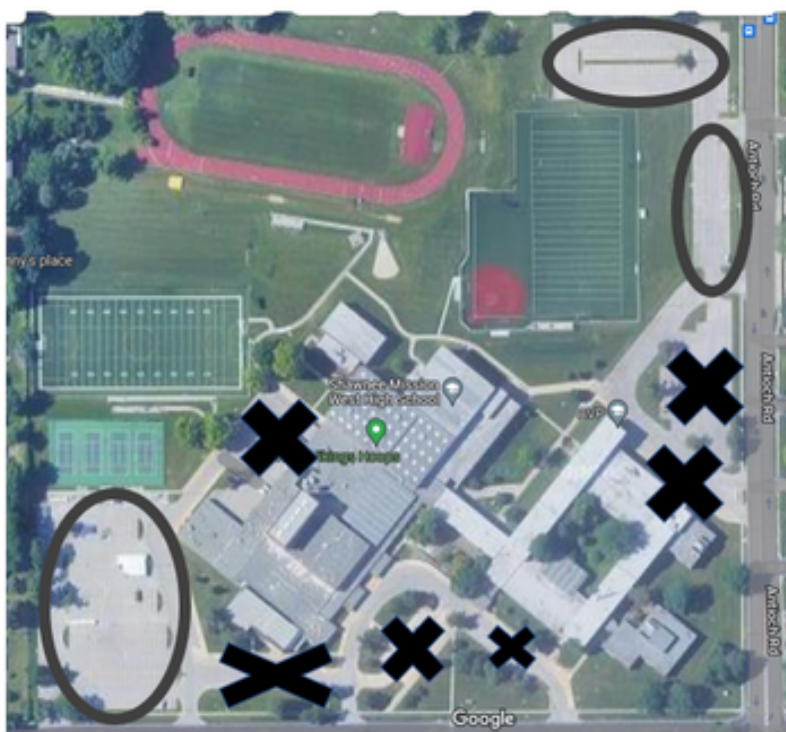

Parking Permits

ICT Updates

We want to remind you of a few things now that we are back in the swing of the school year:

1. Your MacBook must have the district issued case on it at all times. (Failure to have the cover in place will result in confiscation of the MacBook.)
2. Please only carry your MacBook with the screen shut and with both hands to keep the machine secure.
3. Do not ever pick up the MacBook by the screen. The LCD is very sensitive and the pressure of your grip will break the screen.
4. Keyboard covers should not be used since non-Apple keyboard covers might be too large and can put pressure on the screens and cause damage.
5. Please don't leave your MacBook in a car overnight.
6. Needed programs can be found on Manager. You will not be able to download programs from the App Store for use on these devices.
7. Downloading VPNs (Virtual Private Networks) or other programs that mask your device on the network are a violation of the Responsible Use Policy you have agreed to. Use of these will result in the confiscation of the MacBook and you may MacBook access for the semester/school year for consistent violations.
8. Due to the MacBook refresh this summer and the cost of the new hardware, the replacement device cost has gone up. Although, the charger cost has dropped. The incident fees have stayed the same (fees reset in high school).
 1. 1st Incident/Damaged Device fee: \$100.00
 2. 2nd Incident/Damaged Device fee: \$150.00

3. 3rd and Subsequent Incident/Damage Device fee: Actual cost of repair/replacement or \$300.00 whichever is greater.

4. Apple MacBook Air M1 USB-C Cable Replacement - \$19

5. Apple MacBook Air M1 Charger Replacement - \$39

6. Apple MacBook Air M1 Adapter Set Replacement - \$58

7. Apple MacBook Air M1 Replacement/Lost Device fee - \$1,117.95

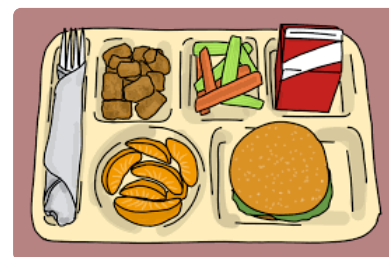

Message from Food Service

Students are able to purchase breakfast and lunch prepared by our food service staff. Students may also bring sack lunches from home.



SM West does not allow for Door Dash deliveries or for fast food to be delivered to students during the school day.

ONLY SENIORS are allowed to leave campus for lunch - WITH Parent Permission. More information about this privilege will be communicated to seniors soon, but will not begin until potentially after Labor Day.

2023-24 - Child Nutrition Program Meal Benefit Application

Families are encouraged to complete an application for meal benefits – free or reduced priced meals – as part of the Online Verification. The link to the Child Nutrition Program Meal Benefit Application is available on Skyward or the online application is on [School Cafe](#). Families do need to create a School Cafe account if they do not already have one - more information may be located on the [SMSD Food Service Free and Reduced](#) web page. Contact the Food Service office by calling 913-993-9710 for questions on the meal benefit application.

Potential Benefits of Filling out the Application

Families, whose meal benefit application is approved for meal benefits, can receive a breakfast and lunch at the free or reduced price – depending on their qualifying benefit.

Families who complete an application and qualify also generate additional state funds for our schools.

Families who qualify for child nutrition meal benefits, may receive additional benefits such as free/reduced instructional resource fees, transportation fees, and Pre-k enrollment.

Consent for Disclosure and Eligibility

Families are encouraged to complete a Consent for Disclosure form in [Skyward](#) which gives SMSD Food Service permission to share a child's eligibility status information with the programs families designate on the consent form.

Families who are receiving certain types of state assistance, a meal benefit application may not be necessary. If a family is directly certified for meal benefits due to state assistance, Food Service

will email a notification of eligibility. If you receive state assistance and have not received a notification of eligibility, call the [SMSD Food Service office](#) before completing a meal program application.

Families who are directly certified are encouraged to complete a Consent for Disclosure form in Skyward which gives SMSD Food Service permission to share a child's eligibility status information with the programs families designate on the consent form.

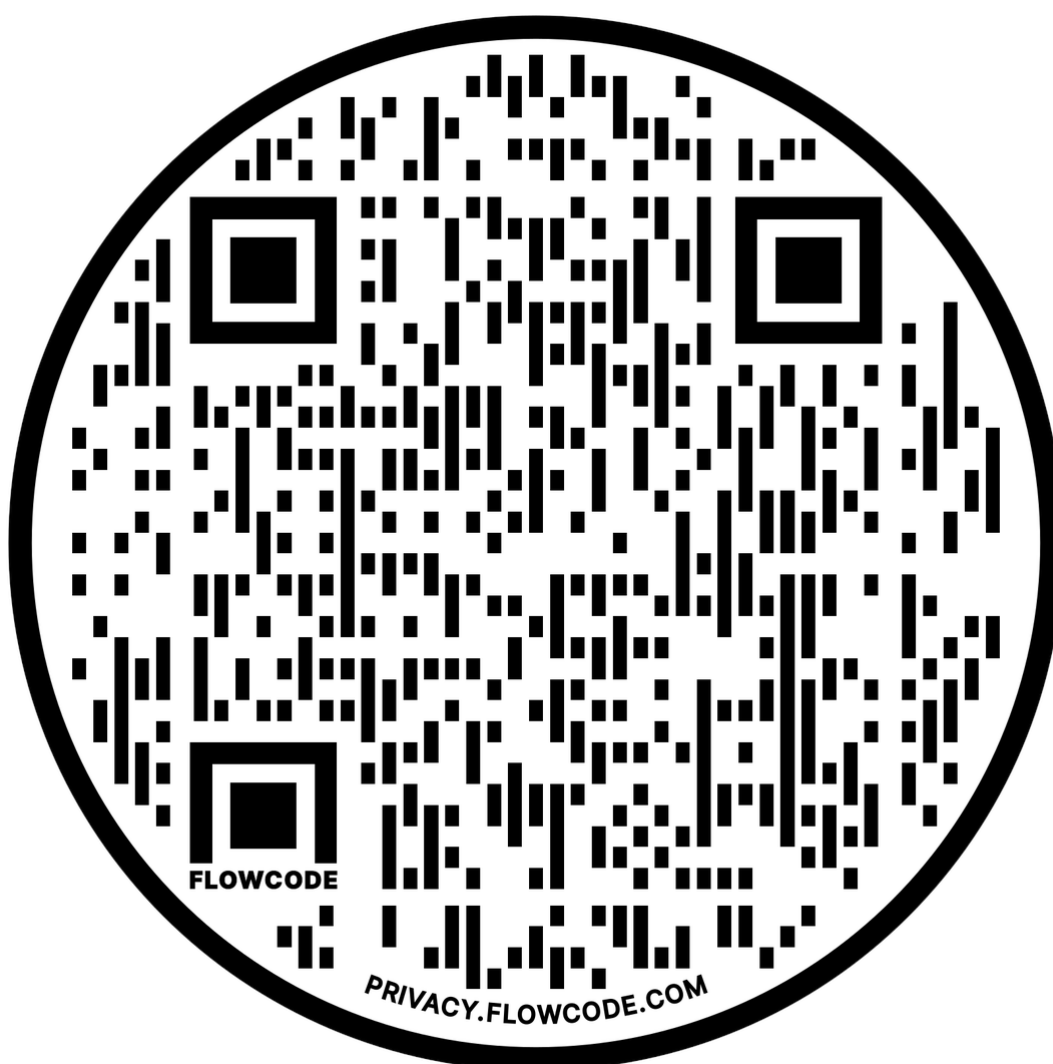
