Lower School FAQ

- Wednesday, May 15, at dismissal time, those parents who have a child participating in the Ram Run will report to the Turf Field. Near the registration tent, you will see designated areas for each grade to meet. Your child will be escorted to the field by an adult.
- Lower School students participating will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- We ask that parents/guardians <u>arrive to the backfield 10 minutes prior</u> to the start times below (2:30 & 2:50):

Early Childhood Arrival at Field: 2:40 p.m. Lower School Grades 1-5 Arrival at Field: 3:00 p.m.

- Once your child arrives, they will leave their backpacks and belongings within the designated area. You will then go to the registration tent.
- We anticipate the event being completed by 4:15 p.m.
- What can my class win with high participation in the event?
