### **UCAS POINTS**

UCAS tariff points are used by some universities, colleges and conservatories as part of their entry requirements. Some of the level 3 LAMDA medal exams hold UCAS Tariff points which translate the exam results into a numerical value - dependent on the qualification size, and the grade achieved.

## HOW DOES LAMDA WORK AT FELSTED?

Students will take their 30 minute class during the school day, the classes are on a carousel and therefore the same lesson will not be missed in a 4 week period. They will also have the opportunity to perform their work in a presentation evening in the Hunt Theatre. Minimal prep is required as the majority of the work will be completed in class. Those who wish to take more than one syllabus are welcome to change syllabi after each exam.

## FEE INFORMATION

Individual and Small Group Fees are based on rates recommended by STSD (Society of Teachers of Speech & Drama) and are in line with the charges for co-curricular activities currently offered at Felsted. As with other tuition, LAMDA tuition will be added to your school bill each term and examination fees are an additional cost. Towards exam time, one or two extra lessons may be booked in order for teachers to conduct a mock exam. We also ask that you provide a 10 week term time notice should your son/daughter wish to cease lessons.
