FROM THE ACADEMIC DEAN STUDENTS IN DANGER OF FAILING

Students must pass all classes for the year, 65% or higher, in order to receive credit. Year-long grades are not indicated on this session report. You must log onto PowerSchool to view the F1 grades. The F1 grade is the grade for the entire year. Any student who does not earn a passing grade of 65 or higher will not receive credit for that class. Freshmen and sophomores can recover credit during summer school for one or two classes, those that fail three or more classes will not be able to return to DPCR. Juniors who fail one class may be asked to leave DPCR as well.

Academic Deans will contact students who have failed classes and their parent/guardians that fail one or more classes the week of May 28 with information regarding credit recovery/summer school.
