



Close Contact COVID Exposure and COVID Positive Guidelines for Employees & Students

If you are feeling ill/sick please see the Health Center or other Healthcare Provider for testing and assessment. At present testing for Influenza (Flu), Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) and COVID 19 is available.

The CDC no longer requires testing due to a close contact or exposure to any respiratory virus (including COVID). Please see the Health Center if you have symptoms of any illness. Please follow guidelines below:

My positive COVID test result was within 30 days or less:

I have symptoms

Use an antigen test. Repeat negative tests following FDA recommendations: **test again 48 hours after the first negative test, then 48 hours after the second negative test, for a total of at least three tests.**

I do not have symptoms

Testing is not recommended to detect a new infection

My positive COVID test results was within 31-90 days

I have symptoms

Use an antigen test. Repeat negative tests following FDA recommendations: **test again 48 hours after the first negative test, then 48 hours after the second negative test, for a total of at least three tests.**

I do not have symptoms

Use an antigen test. May repeat test if symptoms develop.
