



The offense was led by **Chase Bickler**. **Chase** was 2-2, with 3 RBI's and a walk. **Brandon Pate** and **Jack Berriochoa** also had 2 RBI's each. First playoff game starts 4:30 on Monday at Aprende.

JV Baseball:

The regular season for the **JV Baseball team** concluded this week. The team finished the season 7 - 1, with a season ending 6 - 2 win against Akimel. The team enters the playoffs as the #2 seed and will play its first game on Monday, May 13 at Aprende at 4:30pm.
