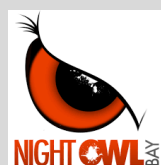
ABOUT US

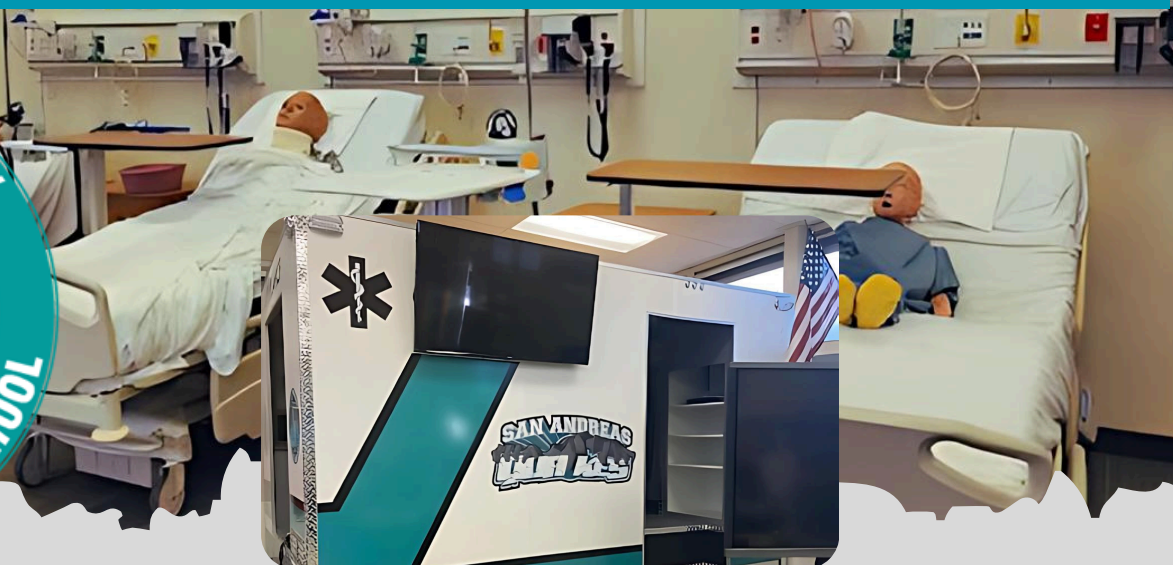
