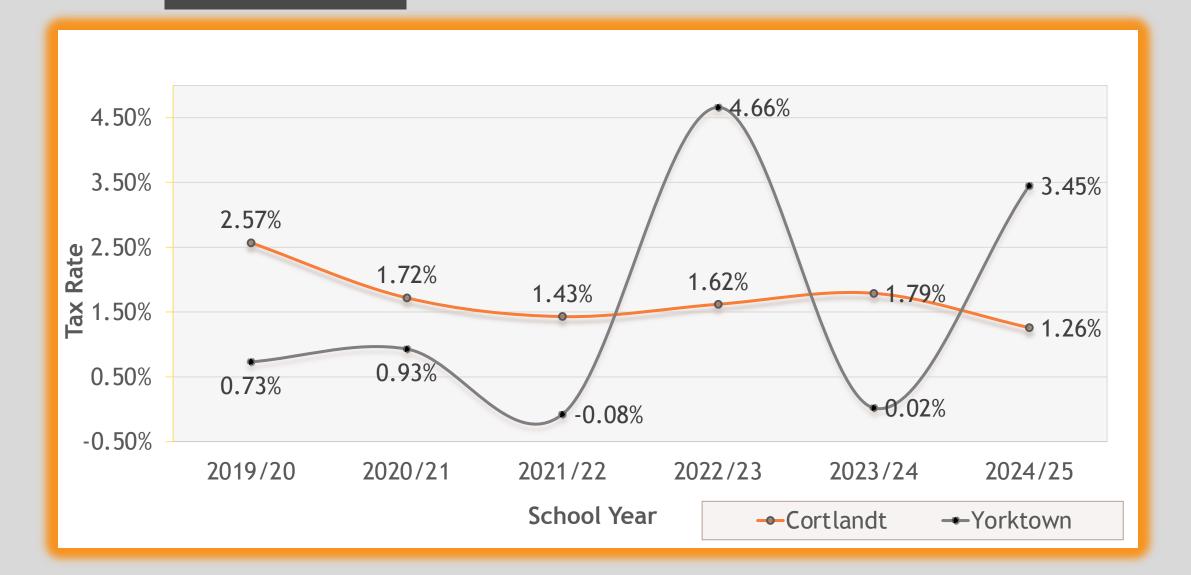

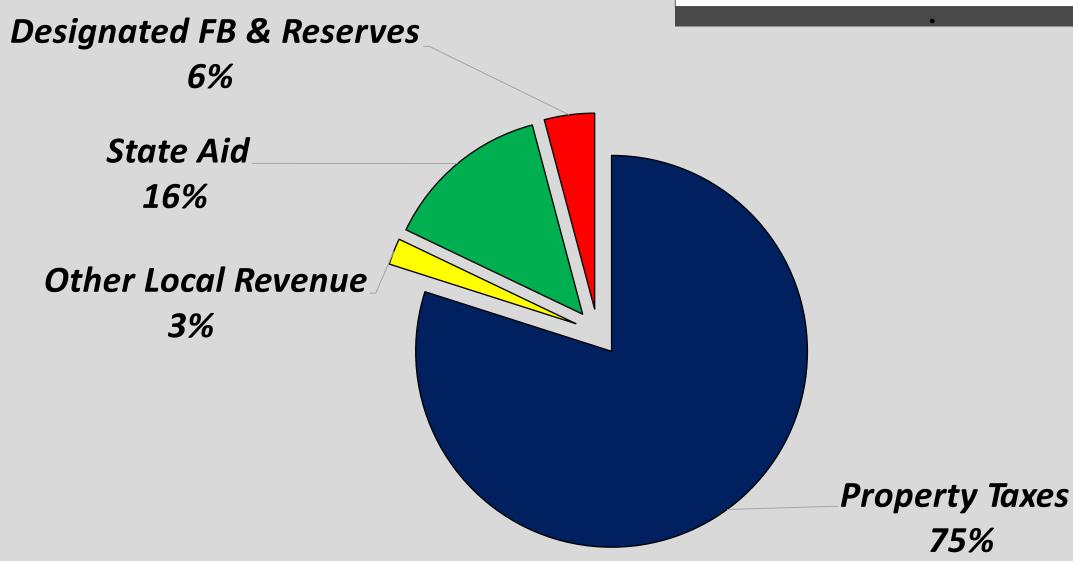
Property Tax Rates

Revenue By Source



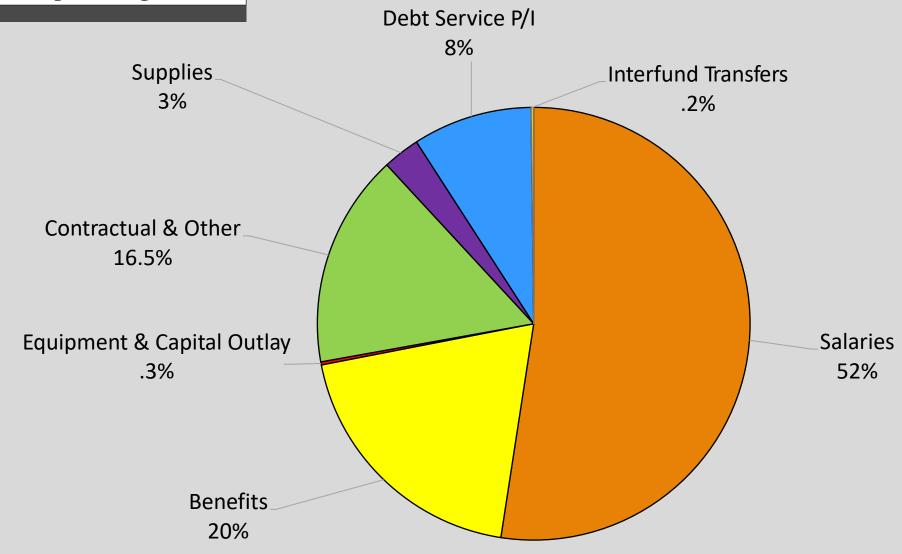

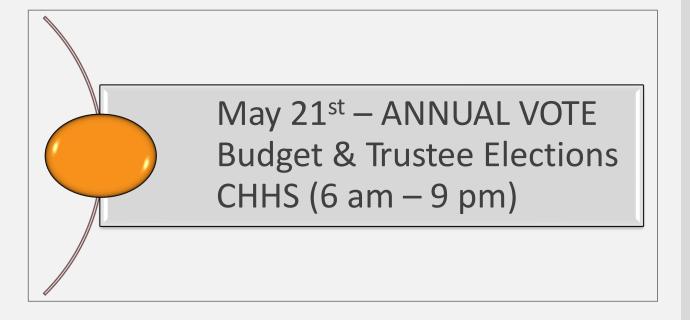

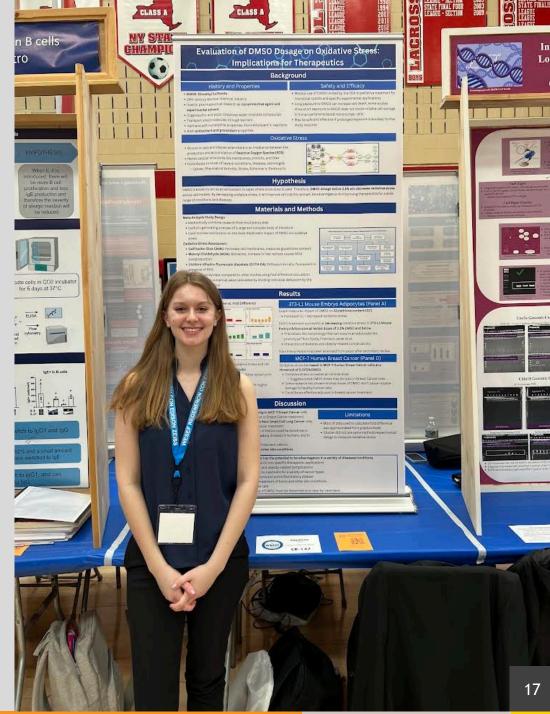

VOTER INFORMATION

- ✓ Voter status may be checked by contacting the District Clerk, Denise Bisaccia at 271-4713 ext. 4227 between 8:00am and 4:00pm or emailing her at Denise.Bisaccia@chufsd.org.
- ✓ To be eligible to vote on May 21, 2024, residents must be registered for general political elections or with the school district or have voted within the past four years in an election.
- ✓ Registrants must be United States citizens, residents of the school district for 30 days, and 18 years of age by May 21, 2024.
- ✓ Register on any business day at the office of the District Clerk during normal business hours up to May 16,
 2024, five (5) days prior to the election.
- ✓ Applications for absentee or early voting ballots for voting and electing board members on the 2024-25 school and library budgets may be obtained from the District Clerk or the website: www.CHUFSD.org.
- ✓ Absentee and Early Voting applications must be submitted at least seven (7) days before the vote/election (May 14, 2024) ior by May 20, 2024, if picked up by the voter.
- ✓ Absentee and Early Voting ballots must be received by the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on the day of the vote/election (May 21, 2024) in order to be counted.
