2. One Lunch-We have a unique lunch period that students are really enjoying. Each day our students are dismissed to lunch on a staggered schedule and are allowed to eat lunch, study, or socialize anywhere in the building. They have over 240,000 sq ft of space that they can spread out into in addition to the open air courtyard.

Breakfast and Lunch are available at no charge to any student for the 21-22 school year. We have 3 lunch lines and the line is usually done in 20 min or less.

Students should not have lunch delivered by food delivery services for any reason. This is a safety concern and food deliveries will be refused or confiscated and repeat offenders risk disciplinary action.

Again, students are provided with meals at no cost so they will not go hungry. We also have vending machines with Smart Snack approved snacks.
