Jesu Meine Freude J.S. Bach

Jesu Meine Freude was composed by J.S. Bach between 1723 and 1727. This movement features German text, a beautiful melody, a variety of styles, and vocal textures.

Sicut cervus G.P. Palestrina

Sicut cervus is a motet for four voices by Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina. This popular polyphonic piece contains beautiful Latin text, a consistent balance of the parts, and an exquisite sense of clarity to it.

Ave verum corpus W.A. Mozart

Ave Verum Corpus is a motet that was composed by Mozart around 1791. Mozart's music is ethereal, translucent, and seemingly simple. This piece, in particular, is homophonic and devoid of flash, which provides the audience a sense of peace.

Flower of Beauty John Clements

Flower of Beauty is a beautiful composition written by John Clements. Clements' strophic melody and warm harmonies are breathtaking in this seamless love song for mixed choirs. Yet, when you sing this text with sensitivity and specificity, this simple tune blooms into a beautiful and touching work of art.

Pilgrims Hymn Stephen Paulus

Pilgrims Hymn is a contemporary acapella piece adapted from text by Michael Dennis Browne. This piece is from the opera "The Three Hermits" and contains minutes of gorgeous harmony until he ends the piece with all four vocal parts on the same note.
