	Workshop Session	Description
Tuesday, May 28th	Under the Sea – Music, Painting – M. Carpenter, K. Burge (K-2)	Journey under the sea! We will give some inspiring ideas for fun ocean crafts and musical activities. Under the Sea will involve sensory activities, creative expression, reading, science experiments and gross motor movements.
	Pop Art Painting – Painting – M. Music (6-8)	In this workshop, students will learn about the fun movement of Pop Art. Students will use various techniques to create their own pop inspired artwork based on an idea of their choice: an animal/pet, favorite person/character, or a fun object. (Prior to the workshop, the instructor will email families to ask for photos if students would like to do an image of a family pet/member.)
	Emotion in Color, Shadow, and Light – Painting - M. Peck (3-8)	Students would learn about color theory in regard to emotion and experiment with mixing colors to evoke different emotions. They would also learn foundational skills of creating shadow and light alongside their emotional affect (this could also incorporate examples from cinema/film).
Wednesday, May 29th	Fairy Houses and Bug Hotels – Sculpture/3D Art – M. Caldera (K-2)	Imaginative play combined with the creation of small structures to house fairies or bugs decorated using mainly natural materials!
	Play in a Day – Theatre – K. Sheanin (3-8)	Students use creativity, imagination, and teamwork to write, produce, direct, and perform a short, one act play at the end of the day. Easily adapted to different age levels. With support from staff, students will brainstorm and write a short play. Students will learn about different roles in the theater and work together to assign roles among the group (props, costumes, set design, directing, stage management, etc.).
	Painting Day and Night – Painting – T.J. Reagan (3-8)	Welcome to Nightscape and Landscape! In this workshop, students will have the opportunity to create both a dreamy painting and a landscape art work – come paint with us!

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Thursday, May 30th	Salt Painting/Paint a Picture on Canvas – Painting – R. Navarrette (3-5)	Come learn the fascinating skill of salt art and canvas painting! Students will have the opportunity to create fun and colorful works of art!
	Mindful Modeling – Sculpture/3D – R. Buckner (3-8)	This workshop is designed to encourage young artists to portray their thoughts and feelings through masks, animal figurines, and cultural artifacts.
	Amazing Anime Characters – Painting – E. Woods (6-8)	Learn the art of anime! In this workshop, students will practice and refine the basics of their anime art!
Tuesday, June 4th	Animal Movements and Music – Theatre, Music – M. Caldera (3-5)	Animal charades, exploration of animal gait patterns and movement, paired with music - likely composed using digital tools while students move through the space embodying traits of different animals
	Slime Factory – Sensory Art – K. Sheanin (K-5)	Prepare to be slimed! Students learn about how to make different textures of slime, pick a theme (ex. space, snow, sand, ocean, circus, food, etc.) to base their slime creation off of, and design a plan around their theme. Students use provided materials and slime recipes to execute their design plan.
	Creativity and Clay – 3D/Sculpture – E. Woods (3-5)	In creativity and clay, students would explore the basics of expressing themselves through three dimensions!
Wednesday, June 5th	Sculpture (Day 1) – 3D – M. Music (K-5)	(Must take day 1 and day 2) In Day one of this workshop, students will work to create a fun hanging sculpture using various clay building techniques. Students will also play some fun art inspired games!
	Diamond Art Canvas – Other – R. Navarrette (3-5)	Come learn the fascinating skill of diamond art! Students will have the opportunity to create fun and colorful works of art!
	Wearable Art – Other – T.J. Reagan (3-8)	Make something you can wear! Buttons, pins, bracelets, necklaces, shirts, etc. Printmaking, sculpture and design bring it all together.

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Thursday, June 6th	Sculpture (Day 2) – 3D – M. Music (K-5)	(Must take day 1 and day 2) In Day two of this workshop, students will be able to decorate and adorn their sculptures with paint and other fun art materials.
	Yoga and Creative Expression – Visual/Movement – K. Baker (3-5)	Come experience the creative arts through the peaceful and mindful movements of Yoga! Much like dance, this workshop will encourage creativity and expression through physical movement.
	Printmaking – Painting – K. Sheanin (3-8)	Students will learn about different types of print making and etching and where they came from. Students will be given the opportunity to try out several forms of print making! Students have the opportunity to print their designs on a T shirt to take home with them at the end of the day.
	The Art of Science – Other – M. Garcia (3-5)	Visual art activities tied in with science. Come see the creative side of science, from making salt crystal paintings to melted crayon art!
Tuesday, June 11th	Squeegee Abstract Art – Painting – A. Farrell (K-8)	Drip, slide and create a modern masterpiece! It's the most fun way to make abstract art. Welcome to our Child Squeegee Art Class, where young imaginations meet vibrant creativity! In this dynamic workshop, children will embark on a colorful journey using the humble squeegee as their paintbrush. Guided by our experienced instructors, kids will explore various techniques to create mesmerizing masterpieces.
	Relief Wall Art/Picture Frames – 3D – M. Music (6-8)	In this workshop students will learn about the art form of relief in order to create an 8x10 foil relief hanging picture frame. Student will also be able to make additional mini artworks to take home. (Prior to the workshop, the instructor will email families to ask for photos if students know of a photo they would like to place in their frame. Otherwise, instructions of how to add a picture will be sent home.)

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Wednesday, June 12th	Flower Crowns – 3D – M. Caldera (K-5)	Overview of the elements of floral design, crafting flower crowns using wire, real or artificial flowers, and ribbon.
	Underwater Adventure – Painting – A. Farrell (K-8)	Dive into creativity with our thrilling Child Art Class: Submarine Exploration! Embark on an underwater adventure as young artists venture into the depths of the ocean to craft captivating scenes of submarines exploring the mysterious seabed. Guided by our passionate instructor, children will learn the fundamentals of composition, perspective, and color theory as they bring their underwater visions to life on canvas.
	Jewelry/Pendant Making – 3D – M. Music (6-8)	In this workshop, students will learn how to use Polymer clay and other materials to create custom wearable art. They will be able to choose from a variety of projects: Pendants, Bracelets, Earrings (students will be able to make multiple if they wish). Students will also have the opportunity to make their own custom buttons and stickers while their jewelry is baked/finished.
Thursday, June 13th	Surreal Landscape – Painting – M. Music (K-5)	In this workshop students will learn about the interesting Art movement of Surrealism. Students will get to make a fun surrealist landscape and self-portrait using things they like!
	Embroidery – Sewing – M. Ka (3-8)	Explore the textile arts through embroidery! Learn valuable skills, such as sewing, and add your own creative flair!
	Tie Dye Workshop – Textile Art – M.S. Verucchi (K-8)	Come get your Tie Dye on! In this workshop, students will learn and participate in the technique of folding and dyeing pieces of fabric of their choice.
