
Students will be required to arrive at TMS by 7:15am and will return approximately 7:15pm.

Dorney Park/Wildwater Kingdom Key Information - Monday, June 17, 2024

Arrival

- Students need to arrive no later than 7:15am on Monday.
- Use the cafeteria entrance and meet in the Main Gym.

Cell Phones

- Cell phones are permitted on the trip. Please make sure that student cell phones are fully charged.
- Students have been told that they may not take or post pictures of students or staff without their consent. **Please reinforce this message at home.**
- All cell phones must be kept in secured pockets during rides at the Amusement Park and in a locker at the Water Park.

Students should bring

- Wear **unaltered** Class of 2028 T-Shirt (This shirt must be worn the entirety of the trip except in the Water Park)
- Sneakers must be worn at the park
- Sun Block
- Additional money for food, arcade games, and souvenirs. Please note: **DORNEY PARK IS CASHLESS.** Students can use Apple/Google-Pay, Credit/Debit Card, or there is a cash-to-card kiosk.
- Students who have epi-pens must carry their pens with them for the entirety of the trip.
- Students are responsible for carrying all personal items.
- If using the Water Park:
 - Bathing Suit
 - Towel
 - Flip-flops (use in Water Park only)
 - Make sure to change back into your Class of 2028 t-shirt and dry clothes for the bus ride home.

The trip includes

- Ticket to the Amusement Park and the Water Park
- 1 Meal Voucher - food/drink
- 1 unlimited Drink wristband

Medication While on the Trip

- Medications, including over-the-counter, require an "[Administration of Medication Form](#)" which requires a doctor's signature. This means that all medication, including all non-prescription medication, must be signed-off by a physician. Medication and forms are due **June 3.**
- If your child requires an epi-pen, be sure your medical forms are updated with the nurse.

- We will have a nurse with us on the trip.

At the Park and Return back at TMS

- Students will have a check-in with the administration team during the day at a designated location.
- We will arrive at TMS at approximately 7:15pm.
- Pick up is at the TMS parking lot. No student pick-ups on Tenafly Road.
- Should there be a delay, students will contact their parents.
- **Important:** Do not park along the curb so that the buses may pull in and unload in a timely and safe manner.
