To complete the online process, click the link and login to <u>Gradebook/Family Access</u>. Click Returning Student Verification on the left. (Do not click New Student Registration for returning students.) Please complete this <u>form</u> if you are not returning to WSISD.

- Proof of residency must be uploaded if the address changed.
