**V. Vote on Executive Session Items**

A. Readmit Hearings

Ms. Kipp moved, Ms. Krause seconded a motion to readmit student A to Charleston County School District. Motion passed 5-0.

Ms. Kipp moved, Mr. Lawrie seconded a motion to readmit student B to Charleston County School District. Motion passed 5-0.

Ms. Kipp moved, Ms. Browder seconded a motion to readmit student C to Charleston County School District. Motion passed 5-0.

Ms. Kipp moved, Mr. Ripley seconded a motion to readmit student D to Charleston County School District. Motion passed 5-0.

B. Discipline Hearings

A motion was made by Ms. Kipp, seconded by Ms. Browder, in lieu of placement into an alternative program, place the student on ADAPT probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year and allow the student/family 30 days to enroll into a licensed/accredited substance abuse support program/counseling services at no cost to CCSD. Failure to do so will result in a probation violation and a reappearance before the D2 Board for further disciplinary action. Motion passed 4-1 (M. Lawrie).

A motion was made by Ms. Kipp, seconded by Mr. Lawrie, in lieu of expulsion, return the student to school on ADAPT probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Student must complete 15 hours of community service by March 31, 2023. Motion passed 5-0.

A motion was made by Ms. Kipp, seconded by Mr. Lawrie, in lieu of expulsion place the student at Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 45 days. Student will be on district probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Motion passed 5-0.

**C. Adult Education Applications (2)**

Ms. Kipp moved, Mr. Lawrie seconded a motion to approve the adult education applications from Lucy Beckham High School. Motion passed 5-0.

**D. Adjournment**
