**I. Call to Order:**

D. A motion was made by Ms. Kipp, seconded by Ms. Krause, to expel the student for the 2022-2023 school year. Student may reappear before the Constituent Board in August to seek readmittance for the 2023-2024 school year. Motion passed 3-0.

E. A motion was made by Ms. Jouan-Goldman, seconded by Ms. Kipp, in lieu of expulsion place the student at Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 45 days. Student will be on district probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Motion passed 3-0.
