Proceedings:

I. Call to Order:

The board meeting was called to order at 5:41 p.m.

In attendance: Pamela Jouan-Goldman, Layne Kipp, Jennifer Bilbro, Dana Krause.

II. Adoption of Agenda:

A motion was made by Ms. Jouan-Goldman, seconded by Ms. Krause, in lieu of expulsion return the student to school on district probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Student must write 3 apology notes; one to his mother, one to his grandmother and one to the school. These letters must be completed by October 31, 2022. Motion passed 4-0.

A motion was made by Ms. Krause, seconded by Ms. Kipp, in lieu of expulsion placement at Daniel Jenkins Academy until successful completion of the program. Student will also be on district probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Motion passed 4-0.

A motion was made by Ms. Jouan-Goldman, seconded by Ms. Bilbro, in lieu of expulsion placement at Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 45 days. Student will reappear before the board at the completion of his time at Turning Point. Student will also be on district probation for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Motion passed 4-0.

- B. A motion was made by Ms. Jouan-Goldman, seconded by Ms. Bilbro, to approve the hardship transfer request to Belle Hall Elementary. Motion passed 4-0.
